JAPANESE LANGUAGE & CULTURE SEMINAR 2019

This 4-week program is designed for JFL (Japanese as a Foreign Language) students, from HSU's partner universities, who wish to enhance their Japanese language skills and to learn about Japanese culture through classroom instructions, excursions, field trips, communication with HSU students, and a weekend homestay.

Program Fee: ¥185,000 /student (estimated cost)

Program fees include:

- Four weeks of instruction in Japanese language & culture classes (minimum 60 hours) taught by experienced instructors
- Field trips to two World Heritage sites in the Hiroshima area, Peace Memorial Park and Miyajima, and to Otafuku Sauce Manufacturing Company and Mazda Motor Corporation
- Cultural activities (tea ceremony, etc.)
- Transportation between Hiroshima Airport/Hiroshima Station and HSU campus upon arrival and departure
- Breakfast from Monday through Friday
- Wi-Fi access on campus
- Access to university facilities (library, swimming pool, etc.)
- Welcome Party
- One weekend homestay
- Accommodation costs for the on-campus Seminar House during the program
- Issuance of certificates of completion and student performance grades

Program fees do not include:

- Lunch and dinner on weekdays and all meals on weekends
- Liability and health insurance
- Local transportation fees outside of the program

*Fees and schedules are subject to change and availability.

*No fees will be returned after the start of the program.

The maximum number of participants is **30**, and we are able to accept a total of 5 participants from each partner university.

The application deadline is **April 26, 2019**. The application period will close early if the maximum number of participants is reached.

Course Description

- **“Japanese Language”** courses are offered at three proficiency levels (Beginning, Elementary, Intermediate) based on the results of the placement test conducted on the first day.

Around the final day of the program, students will give a presentation.

- **“Japanese Lifestyle & Culture”** courses are offered by four teachers in the following four different topics.

1. World Heritage Sites in Hiroshima
2. Tea Ceremony and Hiroshima Cuisine
3. Student Exchange and Student Life in Japan
4. Images of Japan in Western Cinemas

The courses will be delivered in Japanese or in Japanese/English.
